PROMOTE CULTURE BASED HOLISTIC EDUCATION :

VICE PRESIDENT

New Delhi: Holistic education is the need of the hour. So said the Honourable Vice-President of India, Shri Venkaiah Naidu at the diamond jubilee celebrations of P.G.D.A.V College (Evening), a constituent college of the University of Delhi, today. Noting that the youth are in a formative stage of their lives, he said that not only should education arm students with knowledge, it should also ground the younger generation in ethical principles and spirituality, a sense of social service, and love for the culture and traditions of our ancient land. Further, it should promote physical fitness and a healthy lifestyle. Noting that P.G.D.A.V College (Evening) is “one of the best colleges in the top ranking University of Delhi”, Shri Naidu lauded the DAV family of over a thousand institutions for taking forward Maharishi Dayanand Saraswati's call to blend modern scientific temper with our ancient Vedic wisdom.



He observed that this message should be disseminated in every nook and corner of our country. “We should be rooted in our culture but not insulated in our outlook,” he said. In a wide-ranging address lasting over half an hour and peppered with characteristic humour and witticisms, the Honourable Vice President dwelled on numerous themes that are of concern to the nation today and particularly to our youth.



He wanted education to rid the youth of the colonial mind-set and inculcate in them knowledge of our history and a love for our culture and traditions. He noted that India was known as 'Vishwaguru' that had imparted education in the past through universities like Takshila and Nalanda. According to Shri Naidu, Indian Philosophy is based on the principle of 'share and care' and though this country had been invaded by many foreigners in the past, it had never attacked any country.

His advice to the youth was to respect their parents, their mother land and their mother tongue. He urged the youth to be positive and rued the unfortunate tendency to politicize issues. He felt that they need to imbibe democratic values so that decisions can be reached through debate and discussion. He spoke of the need to eradicate social evils, to empower women, to care for nature, and to generate new ideas for the betterment of humanity. Pointing out that India was a bright spot in a weak world economy, Shri Naidu described India as a land of opportunities where, no matter how humble one's background, big dreams backed by hard work bring success.



The Vice-Chancellor of Delhi University, Prof Yogesh Tyagi also addressed the gathering and congratulated P.G.D.A.V College (Evening) on completing sixty years of its existence. Recalling the teaching and service of Maharishi DayanandSaraswati, Mahatma Hansraj and others, he observed that D.A.V institutions have a great legacy. Prof. Tyagi stated that introspection should go hand in hand with celebration. Describing teaching as “a noble profession”, he urged teachers to ensure that they were worthy of the faith reposed by parents in entrusting their children to their care. He also urged students to devote themselves sincerely to studies so that they could challenge teachers to give them their best. Noting that the University of Delhi had recently undertaken a big exercise in revising over a thousand postgraduate courses, Prof. Tyagi urged teachers to ensure that they provide a bridge between school and university education since academic growth has to be a continuum without any gaps.



Dr. R. K. Gupta, Principal of P.G.D.A.V College (Evening), presented a report on the College achievements. He recalled that starting from a small scale in 1958, the College now had 85 teachers, 62 rooms and over 2000 students studying 6 undergraduate courses. He disclosed that the college would be soon offering an English Honours course as well as M. Com classes. In addition to various facilities offered to students, Dr. Gupta listed numerous special initiatives taken by the college that demonstrate its commitment to the holistic development of students as well as to society and the

environment. These include a mentor – mentee system, association with SPICMACAY, provision of a sanitary napkin vending machine, a multi-purpose smart Identity card to ensure a digital and cashless campus, a Yoga club, 'Sansparsh' initiative to collect clothes and books for the destitute, 'Shubhashish' initiative to sensitize the younger generation to the needs of senior citizens, rainwater harvesting, e-waste management, an air quality monitoring station, a proposed solar plant, etc. Dr. Gupta said that the College hosts national and international seminars on various academic issues on a regular basis. He pointed out that P.G.D.A.V College (Evening) has received a Spiritual and Value Education Award from World Agency for Value Education in collaboration with the Confederation of Indian Universities. A Sanskrit play, 'Parivartan', enacted by the college students at many prestigious venues has received much acclaim.

After the Principal's report, the Honourable Vice-President released a special issue of the College annual magazine 'Neelambra' focussing on Maharishi DayanandSaraswati. A booklet titled 'Shubhashish', marking the college's engagement with its social responsibility, was also released on the occasion.

Many dignitaries and luminaries associated with the college were present on the occasion. These included Shri T. N. Chaturvedi, Chairman of the Governing Body, Dr. Satish Sharma, Director (Colleges) of the D.A.V College Managing Committee, many former Principals and faculty members. The programme began with a ceremonial lighting of the lamp followed by 'SaraswatiVandana'. Shri Chaturvedi delivered the welcome speech while a formal vote of thanks was proposed by Dr. Satish Sharma. After the speeches were over, an hour long cultural programme on the theme 'Ek Bharat, Shresth Bharat' was staged by the college students. It showcased the rich and diverse cultural heritage of India and brought out beautifully the unity in diversity that exists in our country. The stage proceedings were conducted by senior faculty members Dr. Rukmini and MsAshma Bhatia.

150th Birth Anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi Celebrations by Virasat

The Department of History, to celebrate the 150th Birth Anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi had planned a series of programmes. This had to begin with a lecture on Mahatma Gandhi by an eminent scholar. Dr. Mridula Arora, the Teacher in-charge of the department requested Professor Anand Kumar, formerly at Jawaharlal Nehru University, who very kindly gave consent for the lecture despite of his hectic schedule. This lecture, which was an inaugural programme too, entitled “Rashtra Nirman ki chunautiyan: Gandhiji ki Virasat” was organized on 25.02.2019 at 4:00 P.M. in the old seminar hall of the College. Dr. Mridula Arora hosted the programme. The programme began with the lightening of the lamps. Principal Dr. R.K. Gupta in his welcome address remembered the day when Prof. Anand Kumar had last deliberated on relevance of Dr. Ambedkar in the College. Commemoration of 100 years of Jallianwalah Bagh Massacre (1919) *Samprabhu*, the Political Science society and Virasat, the History Society came together to organize a commemoration programme for the 100th Anniversary of the massacre in association of the Film Appreciation Committee of the College on 12 April, 2019 at 3:00p.m. in the Old Seminar Hall. The programme started with the lightening of the lamp and remembering the martyrs of the Jallianwalah Bagh. In the first part of the programme a documentary film produced by the Film Division, Government of India was screened for the audience. The documentary was not only rich in content but also had original video footages of the time, which helped the students, understand the situation of the days when protests related to the Rowlett Act were being held. After the screening of the film, Dr. S.R. Raj, convener of *Samprabhu* introduced the guest speakers, Dr. Anil Dutta Mishra, Eminent Gandhian Scholar and Dy. Director, National Gandhi Museum and Dr. Shriram Oberoi, Associate Professor (Retd.), University of Delhi to the audience. In his Welcome Address, Principal Dr. R. K. Gupta highlighted the courage and determination of Udham Singh who was present in the Jallianwalah Bagh when this brutal killing was going on and took revenge of the massacre by killing one of the responsible British officials. Dr. Anil Dutta Mishra began his speech by remembering the martyrs of Jallianwallah and related this incident with the beginning of mass politics. He said that this incident inspired many revolutionary and changed the course of Indian National Movement. He emphasized on the fact that Gandhiji got convinced of his idea that the goal of Swarajya can only be achieved through non-violence after this mass murder only. Dr. Shriram Oberoi, in his deliberation, emphasized on the fact that the Jallianwalah Bagh massacre was not the first mass murder of Indians by a foreign power, rather it was one of the bloodiest. He remembered the killings ordered by Nadir Shah, the Persian invader and then by Ahmad Shah Abdali. He then elaborated upon the incidents that evolved into the mass murder. After both the lectures, question-answer session started, in which, the students enquired into many aspects of the massacre. Around hundred students and teachers from across the departments participated in the seminar. The programme came to an end with the vote of thanks by Dr. Sanjay Kumar of Department of History.

Loksabha TV Dr. Bhim Rao Ambedkar Jayanti 10-04-2019

Report

The Media Cell of PGDAV College (E) along with Lok Sabha TV conducted a discussion on the topic “Bhartiya Samaaj Main Samrasta : Hamara Udeshaya” keeping Dr. B.R. 

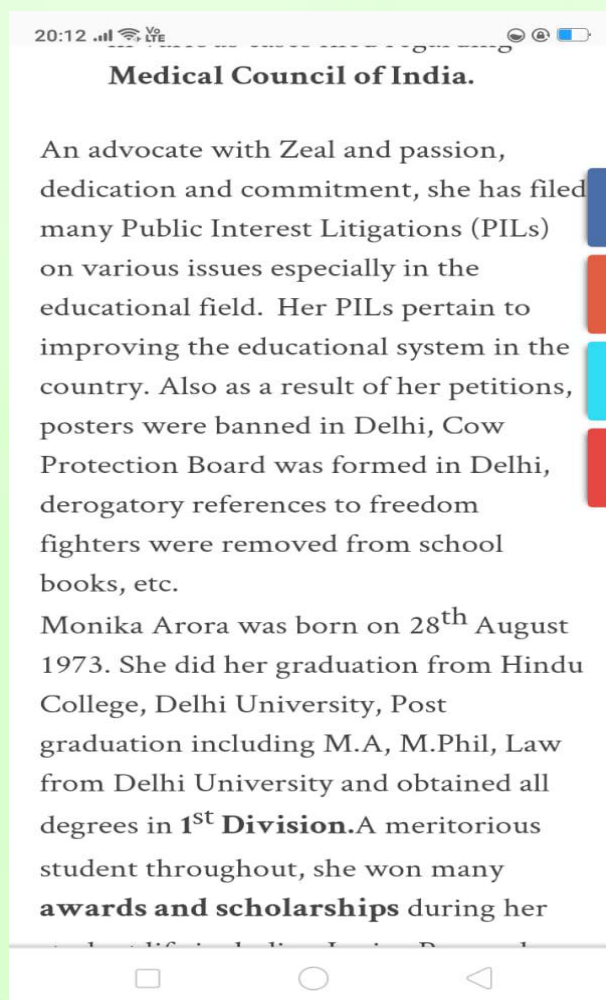
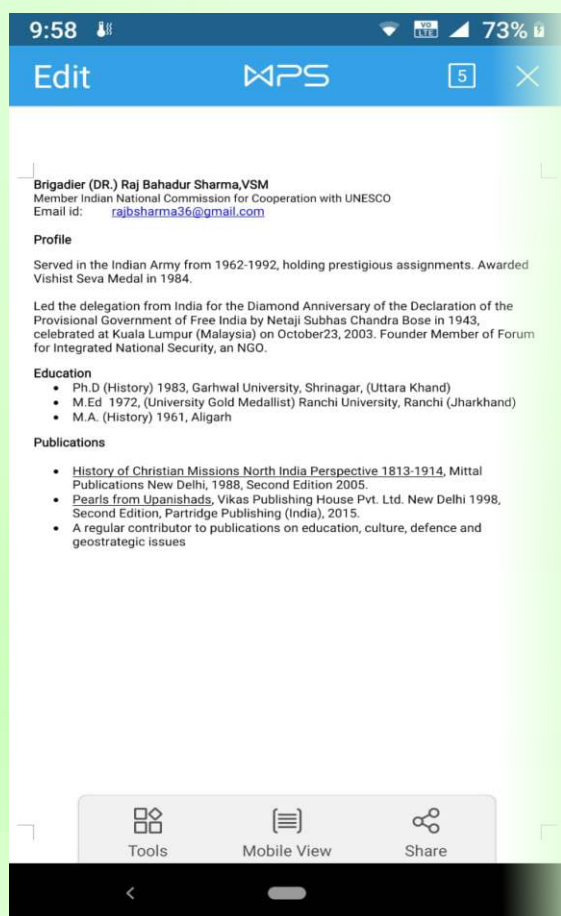

Report on Talk by Culture and Ethics Cell and Women Development Cell

She also expressed her concern on today's scenario where few people want to divide India. She gave several examples to illustrate that despite of huge diversity, there is unity and oneness in the country. She also warned the youth about the misuse of technology and advised them to use it in a creative manner. She concluded with a motivational shayari and left the audience spellbound. The program concluded with a formal vote of thanks by Dr. Rukmini, the convenor of Women Development Cell.



Commemoration of 100 years of JallianwalahBagh Massacre (1919)

Samprabhu, the Political Science society and Virasat, the History Society came together to organize a commemoration programme for the 100th Anniversary of the massacre in association of the Film Appreciation Committee of the College on 12 April, 2019 at 3:00p.m. in the Old Seminar Hall. The programme started with the lightening of the lamp and remembering the martyrs of the Jallianwalah Bagh. In the first part of the programme a documentary film produced by the Film Division, Government of India was screened for the audience. The documentary was not only rich in content but also had original video footages of the time, which helped the students, understand the situation of the days when protests related to the Rowlett Act were being held. After the screening of the film, Dr. S.R. Raj, convener of *Samprabhu* introduced the guest speakers, Dr. Anil Dutta Mishra, Eminent Gandhian Scholar and Dy. Director, National Gandhi Museum and Dr. Shriram Oberoi, Associate Professor (Retd.), University of Delhi to the audience. In his Welcome Address, Principal Dr. R. K. Gupta highlighted the courage and determination of Udham Singh who was present in the JallianwalahBagh when this brutal killing was

going on and took revenge of the massacre by killing one of the responsible British officials. Dr. Anil Dutta Mishra began his speech by remembering the martyrs of Jallianwallah and related this incident with the beginning of mass politics. He said that this incident inspired many revolutionary and changed the course of Indian National Movement. He emphasized on the fact that Gandhiji got convinced of his idea that the goal of Swarajya can only be achieved through non-violence after this mass murder only. Dr. Shriram Oberoi, in his deliberation, emphasized on the fact that the JallianwalahBagh massacre was not the first mass murder of Indians by a foreign power, rather it was one of the bloodiest. He remembered the killings ordered by Nadir Shah, the Persian invader and then by Ahmad Shah Abdali. He then elaborated upon the incidents that evolved into the mass murder. After both the lectures, question-answer session started, in which, the students enquired into many aspects of the massacre. Around hundred students and teachers from across the departments participated in the seminar. The programme came to an end with the vote of thanks by Dr. Sanjay Kumar of Department of History.

2019-02-26 Time Institute

A talk was organised by the Kautilya Parishad on 26th Feb, 2019 on 'Eco- Fundas'. The speaker was Mr. Amit Poddar, Senior regional Head, T.I.M.E. pvt ltd. The faculty of Economics Department along with the speaker and his team inaugurated the session with the ceremonial lamp lighting ceremony. 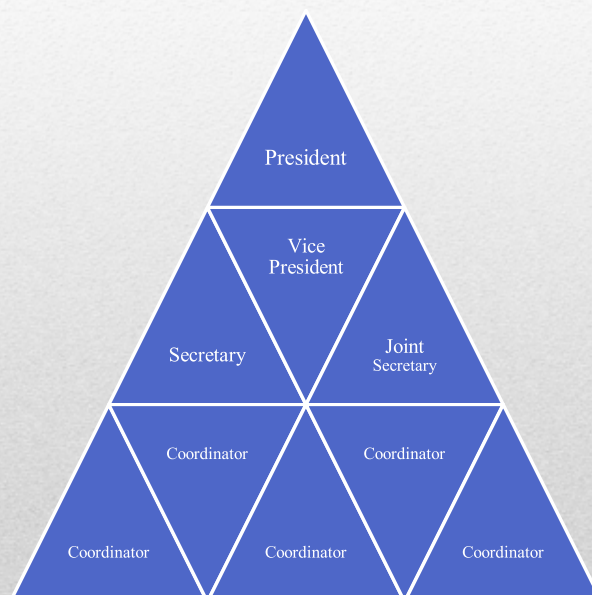

Time: 10:00 AM onwards

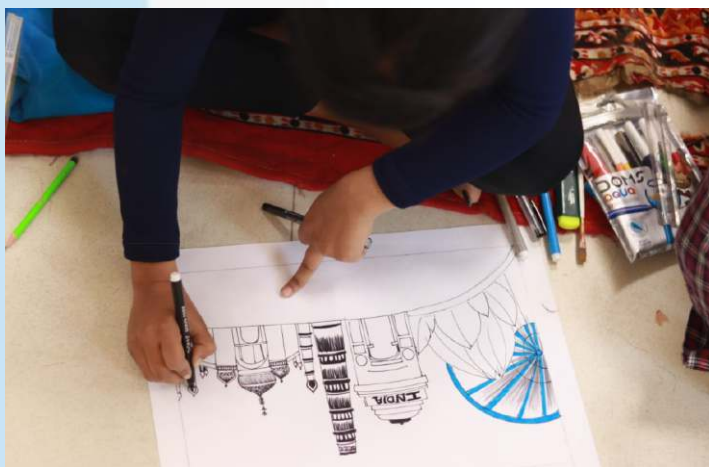
Venue: Old Seminar Hall, P.G.D.A.V. College (Eve.)

एक ऐसी यात्रा जहाँ सेवदानीएँ भाव शून्य हो गयी मन मस्तिष्क में केवल सवाल उठते हैं कि हम कहाँ जा रहे हैं। किस दिशा में जा रहे हैं। यह यात्रा-वृत्तांत एक वृद्ध आश्रम की है। इस आश्रम में लगभग 200 लोगों की रहने की व्यवस्था है। समय पर दवाई नास्ता एवं खाना ही अच्छी व्यवस्था की है। जो बिमार हैं उनके लिए पर्याप्त स्वस्थ सुविधा उपलब्ध है। उनके लिए अलग-से-वार्ड है जैसे कि किसी अस्पताल में होते होती। अलग से जाँच-घर, एक्स-रे मशीन एवं दवाई की उपयुक्त व्यवस्था है। साफ-सफाई की स्थिति संतोषजनक है। वहाँ जुड़े सभी कर्मचारी एवं सहायक गण काफी मिलनसार एवं सहयोग करने वाले हैं। दिल्ली के बदरपुर बॉर्डर के पास आलीगाँव में अवस्थित 'गुरु विश्राम वृद्ध आश्रम' इस दिशा में संवेदनशीलता के साथ इस सेवा कर्म को आगे बढ़ा रहा है। इस आश्रम के संयोजन डॉ० जी.पी. भगत हैं।

यहाँ रहने वाले लोगों के बारे में यदि बात करे तो कुछ लोग ऐसे हैं जिसे आश्रम ने अपनी व्यवस्था से दिल्ली के सड़कों से उठा कर लाया है, कुछ लोग स्वेच्छा से भी आए हैं जिसे इलाज के लिए पर्याप्त धन एवं खाने की समस्या थी, इन्हीं में से कुछ लोग दिल्ली के अस्पतालों द्वारा भी भेज दिए गए हैं जिसके आगे पीछे कोई भी पारिवारिक अपना सदस्य नहीं होता, जिससे इस वृद्ध आश्रम में उनके देखभाल, खाना-पीना और समुचित इलाज संभव हो सके। परन्तु, अधिकांश वैसे भी लोग हैं जिनके अपनों ने ही उन्हें या तो अपने ही घर से निकाला हो या निकल जाने को मजबूर हुए हो। महत्वपूर्ण बात यह भी है कि ये बुजुर्ग कभी अपने बच्चों को आरोपित नहीं करते और नहीं दोष देते हैं। उन्हें विश्वास है कि एक दिन वे आयेंगे और उन्हें ले जायेंगे। यह अत्यंत दुःखद एवं चिंता का विषय है। जो संवेदनाओं को भाव-शून्य का देती है और आप-हम और हम विभिन्न तरह के सवालों से घिर जाते हैं। यह किसी भी सभ्य-समाज की विशेषता तो नहीं हो सकती। समाज, संस्कृति संस्कार और बाजार के आत्मद्वंद एवं संघर्ष की परिस्थिति हो सकती है जिस पर समय रहते विचार किए जाने की आवश्यकता है।

उसी कड़ी में एक संबंधित प्रस्ताव मैं जब अपने प्राचार्य डॉ० रविन्द्र कुमार गुप्ता सर के समक्ष रखा तो उन्होंने सहर्ष स्वीकार करते हुए हमें आगे बढ़ने को कहा। इस प्रस्ताव में हमें अपने ही कॉलेज के छात्र-छात्राओं को वृद्ध आश्रम में ले जाना था जहाँ उन्हें उनकी सेवा करनी थी, उनसे बातचीत करना था और पूरी संवेदनाओं के साथ उन्हें अपनापन देना था। पहली अगस्त 2018 को मैं अपने तृतीय वर्ष के राजनीति विज्ञान (प्रतिष्ठा) के एक छात्र एवं तीन छात्राओं के साथ गुरु विश्राम वृद्ध आश्रम गया। वहाँ के संयोजक एवं सहायकों से बातचीत की और अपना उद्देश्य बताया। संयोजक डॉ० भगत ने कहा कि धन देने वालों की शायद कमी नहीं है लेकिन आप जिसकी समय, सेवा, संवेदनाएँ और अपना अपनापन चर्चा कर रहे हैं हमारे इन बुजुर्गों को इसी सर्वाधिक जरूरत है। आपका बहुत-बहुत स्वागत है। तब से लेकर आज तक अलग-ललग ग्रुप में अपने विद्यार्थियों के साथ चार बार जा चुके हैं।

कॉलेज के बस स्टॉप पर सबको एकत्र होना और एकत्र होने के लिए सबको फोन से सूचित करना, इस परियोजना का एक एक महत्वपूर्ण विषय है फिर बस नं० 460 या 479 पकड़कर आलीगाँव पैदल चलकर वहाँ पहुँचना, बच्चों के मन में कई तरह के सवाल उठते रहे हैं कि किस तरह बातचीत की शुरुआत होगी और बातचीत का विषय क्या-क्या होगा। इन सवालों के बीच में उनके मन की जिज्ञासा भी उनके उत्साह को बढ़ाने का काम किया। हमारी तीसरी यात्रा 11 अगस्त 2018 को 19 विद्यार्थियों के साथ हुई। वहाँ पहुँचते ही व्यवस्थापकों ने सात के विद्यार्थियों के अलग-अलग ग्रुप को दिखाने का निर्णय लिया। सबसे पहले किचन, फिर उस वार्ड को दिखायें जिसमें वहाँ के कई वृद्ध सदस्यों का इलाज चल रहा था। बच्चों ने बहुत ही अपनेपन से उनकी सेवा की। हाथ-पैर में मालिश के साथ उनके माथे को, आँखों को बहुत ही प्यार से सहलाया। मैं भी वहाँ मौजूद था। मैंने उनकी आँखों में, जो भावना शून्य हो चुका था, भावनाओं को फिर से आते हुए देखा, शायद ने अपने अतीत की यात्रा कर रहे होंगे जब अपने हाथों से अपने नन्हें-मुन्नों को पाला-पोषा होगा। उनके चेहरे के भाव के पल-पल में बदलते हुए मैं महसूस किया। शायद वे ऐसा कह रहे हो कि आप सभी अपने माता-पिता को खूब प्यार करपा, कभी अपने से बिछड़ने मत देना। उनके साथ हमारा आत्मीय मिलन के साथ ही सारी भौतिक दूरियाँ भी मिटती गई। थोड़े ही समय में हम एक परिवार की तरह व्यवहार कर रहे थे।

25 अगस्त 2018 को तीसरी यात्रा की और इस दिन ओणम का पर्व था इसमें 17 विद्यार्थी शामिल हुए। अगले दिन रक्षा-बंधन का त्यौहार मनाया जाना था। हम लोगों ने सबकी कलाइयों पर राखी बाँधी और आयोजकों की अनुमति से उन्हें चॉकलेट भी खिलाया। चूँकि थोड़े समय बाद दोपहर के खाने का वक्त हो चुका था, फिर हम लोगों ने उन्हें खुद से खाना खिलाया। जैसे कि आज की गाँवों में पंगत में बैठकर खाना खाते हैं, उसी स्थिति में हम लोगों ने उन्हें अपनी सेवाएँ दी। कुछ बुजुर्ग (महिला एवं पुरुष) ऐसे भी थे जो खुद से खाना नहीं खा रहे थे, हम लोगों ने चम्मचों से से उन्हें खाना भी खिलाया।

22 सितम्बर 2018 को चौथी यात्रा में 26 विद्यार्थी एवं दो अन्य शिक्षक शामिल हुए। हम लोग उस वक्त वहाँ पहुँचे जब उन्हें दवाई खिलाने का समय हो रहा था। फिर हम लोगों ने आयोजकों की अनुमति से उन्हें दवाई भी खिलायी। उनके माथे एवं बालों में तेल लगाया और उनके नाखून भी काटे। इसकी चर्चा में यहाँ इसलिए भी कर रहा हूँ ताकि हम 'मानवीय पक्ष के एकात्मकात' को आपके समझ रख पाएँ। प्रत्येक यात्रा की सर्वाधिक सुखद पहलू यह रहा कि हमारे उनके पास होने पर एहसास के साथ ही उनके चेहरे खिल जाते हैं और यात्रा की समाप्ति के कुछ समय पूर्व हम लोगों के उनके साथ फिल्मी गानों पर नृत्य उनको उनके होने का अहसास दिला पाती है। चूँकि प्रत्येक यात्रा में प्रायः बच्चे बदल जाते हैं लेकिन मेरे साथ उनकी आत्मीयता ऐसी बन गई है कि केवल मेरे उनके अपने-सामने होने भर से हमारे एवं उनके चेहरे पर खुशी की एक लकीर जरूर खींच जाती है।

यही वजह है कि हर बार कुछ लोग जरूर कहते हैं बेटा फिर कब आओग, जलदी ही आना, आप आते हो बहुत अच्छा लगता है। अब तो आयोजक भी कहने लगे हैं कि प्रत्येक सप्ताह आएँ, हमें भी आपके साथ अच्छा लगता है। इस दौरान, एक अन्य स्थिति यह भी आई कि बच्चे हमसे इस बात की अनुमति चाहते लगे कि अकेले या कुछ बच्चे खुद ले यहाँ आने चाहे तो हमें आने दिया जाये। शायद इसे बच्चों में होने वाले सकारात्मक आत्मीय बदलाव के रूप में देखा जा सकता है।

उद्देश्य भी यही है कि हम सभी मनुष्य अपनी एकात्मकता को आत्मीयता के साथ पहचानें। बच्चों को ले जाकर सेवा के माध्यम से उनमें वह स्थिति विकसित हो सके जिससे अपने वाले उनके समय से ऐसी कोई परिस्थिति बिल्कुल भी नहीं बन सके जिससे माँ-पिताजी अपने ही घर से निकाल दिए जाए या निकलने को विवश हों। स्वेच्छ से भुगतान कर सेवा लेने जैसी व्यवस्था को स्वीकार किया भी जा सकता है, परन्तु पूँजीवादी व्यवस्था में विकसित एककी संरचना में बनी। किसी व्यवस्था रूपी विवशता अवश्य स्वीकार हो। कॉलेज एवं हमारा प्रयोजन भी यही है।

इसी कड़ी में 1 अक्टूबर 2018 को कॉलेज में अन्तर्राष्ट्रीय वृद्ध दिवस मनाया गया जिसमें 67 बच्चे और मेरे साथ डॉ कृष्ण मुरारी सर उपस्थित रहे। बच्चों ने अपने-अपने अनुभवों को हमसे साझा किया और अंत में अब तक जो बच्चें नहीं जा पाए थे, उन्हें जाने के लिए प्रेरित एवं अपील भी किया। शिक्षा विवेकशीलता बढ़ाये यह जरूरी है परन्तु, यदि नहीं शिक्षा सेवा, सहनशीलता एवं संवेदना बढ़ाने के योगदान न दें तो चिंता की बात है। इस दिशा में विभाग कॉलेज, प्राचार्य एवं मेरा यह छोटा से प्रयास है।

Training Session on 'Feminine Hygiene' in PGDAV ColLege (Eve.)

The theme of the Training Session was 'Feminine Hygiene' with a particular focus on Menstrual hygiene, which was conducted by a renowned Counsellor and Social Activist Mrs. Vyjayanthi K. The convenor of the cell Dr. Rukmini then gave a brief introduction of the guest along with highlighting the major objectives and activities of the cell. Mrs. Vyjayanthi started the session by interacting with the students and asking them several questions so as to judge their understanding about the menstruation process. Economics Quiz Competition
