GUIDE TO THE TIMETABLE

STEP 1 : Identify your **Course** of study (B. A Programme, B.Com Programme, Hindi Honours, etc.)

STEP 2 : Identify your **Section** (A, B, C, etc).

Hindi Honours, Math Honours, Political science Honours and Sanskrit Honours classes have one section only.

STEP 3 : Identify your Papers, that is, the papers allocated to you on the basis of your eligibility or

the papers opted by you (in case of elective papers)

In every table, information is presented in the following order:

- 1. The **Period** in which the class will be held (3.00 4.00 p.m, 4.00 5.00 p.m). etc.)
- 2. The name of the **Subject / Paper** that you have to study.

If you find more than one paper in a box (as in the B. A Programme timetables), only ONE of these will be relevant to you – the one allotted to / opted for by you.

3. The Room number in which the class will be held.

This is indicated in round brackets. For example, (26) means the class will be held in Room number 26.

NOTE THAT UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE, ALL CLASSES WILL BE HELD ONLINE.

4. The name of the Teacher who will take the class.

Teacher names are indicated in the boxes using abbreviations.

5. The Days on which the class will be held and the Nature of the class (that is, lecture, tutorial or practical).

Days are indicated using numbers as follows:

 $1 \rightarrow$ Monday, $2 \rightarrow$ Tuesday, $3 \rightarrow$ Wednesday, $4 \rightarrow$ Thursday, $5 \rightarrow$ Friday, $6 \rightarrow$ Saturday

A tutorial class is indicated using a 't' after the day. For example '3t' means a tutorial class on Wednesday.

A **practical class** is indicated using a 'p' after the day. For example '4p' means a practical class on Thursday.
