All the students of Semester II are required to fill an online '**Choices cum Feedback Form**' to select the Value addition course (VAC), Skill Enhancement Course (SEC), Ability Enhancement Course (AEC), Generic Elective (GE) and Discipline Specific Elective (DSE) papers that they wish to study in Semester III. Feedback is also to be filled for Semester II, March – July 2023. **To fill the 'Choices cum Feedback Form' online use the link given below:**

General Instructions

1. Fill up the form carefully. If you feel the need, you can consult your teachers for guidance. You can also check out the syllabi of the different papers on the Delhi University website.
Request for change in papers will not be entertained after you have submitted the form.
2. In the case of some papers, you have been asked to give more than one preference. This is because some of the papers on the list may get withdrawn at a later stage. This can happen, for example, when too few students opt for a paper. On the other hand, if too many students choose a paper, it may not be possible to accommodate everybody in that class. In these cases, you may not get the paper of your first choice and will be given the paper of your second preference. Therefore, **wherever you are asked to give more than one preference**, make sure that you choose a different paper for each preference. That is, **the paper of your second preference must be different from the paper of your first preference**
3. Fill in your details carefully. On submitting your form, you will receive a confirmation e-mail. If you do not get the mail immediately, it will be sent to you in two to three days. Retain the e-mail that you receive till your exams are over.
4. **Submit the form only once.** Multiple submissions will lead to the cancellation of your preference requests.
5. **The last date for the submission of your form is Wednesday, 2nd August 2023.** ***If you do not submit the form by this date, you will lose the chance to choose the papers that you wish to study.*** The college will compulsorily allot papers to you on the basis of administrative convenience and the choice of the college will be binding on you.
