Report of the College Cells, Clubs, Committees and Societies:

Add-on Course: Legal awareness

In addition to the formal courses, the college has introduced many supplementary courses with an objective of nurturing highlighting the natural talent and creative skills of the students and for their holistic personality development. In pursuance of this idea, the first batch of ‘Legal Awareness’ course was started in the college in 2016. Since then, a total of 12 batches have been completed till date. The eleventh batch of ‘Legal Awareness’ consisting of 50 students started on 12 February 2022 under the leadership of Dr Meena Sharma. On the occasion of its inauguration, the Judge of the District Court of South East Delhi was invited as the Guest of Honour. He apprised the participants about the basic aspects of law and their importance. A total of ten class-sessions were arranged in this course. Along with this, the functioning of the court was explained in detail to the students by making arrangements for a visit to the court premises. A visit to Tihar Jail was also organised, with an objective of apprising the students of the life-style and mentality of the prisoners in the jail. Later, these students were also made para- legal volunteers, under which they went to the slums located at Okhla, Srinivaspuri, Govindpuri, Kalkaji etc. and informed the residents about free legal advice. On 30 August 2022, the twelfth batch of this course was started, in which 50 students got registered. Delhi Legal Service Authority (DLSA) Chief Chairman Mr. Sanjay Garg-I, Mr. Bharat Parashar ji and Mr. Mati Isha Singh ji guided the students as the Chief Guest. This batch successfully completed the course on December 14, 2022.

Add-on Course: Skill Development and Data Analytics

A seven day workshop on ‘Skill Development and Data Analytics’ was organized in the college from September 12-19, 2022 by the Institution’s Innovation Council (IIC), Women Development Cell (WDC) and World University Service (WUS), in collaboration with Learning Links Foundation (LLF), a non-profit organisation dedicated to enriching lives through learning. The objective of this program was to encourage students to build their interest, knowledge and expertise in a high-demanding Technology/STEM career path of data and analytics. It also aimed at enhancing the job readiness skills of the beneficiaries and to provide them an opportunity to enroll in globally recognized certification programs through online skill development platforms such as Coursera, Udemy etc. The workshop was conducted online on Zoom platform. COVID-19 Task Force

In response to the COVID-19 outbreak, the PGDAV College (Eve) had convened a Covid-19 Task force in the year 2020 to deal with the situation arising due to pandemic and to make recommendations so that the academic activities are maintained and the administrative responsibilities are taken care of in view of the constantly emerging circumstances. The Covid-19 task force central focus was on protecting the health and safety of students, faculty and staff, to aware the stakeholders about the COVID-19 protocols provided by the health authorities for educational institutions, to reduce the student dropouts during the pandemic due to the financial crisis, to implement the advisories and guidelines issued by the Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of NCT of Delhi, Ministry of Education, University Grants Commission and University of Delhi from time to time so that the Covid related preventive protocols were adopted in letter and spirit and the students and faculty were protected from undue hardship. The Principal Prof R K Gupta, the Covid-19 task force Convenor Prof B N Choudhary and members discussed collaboratively on objectives and came up with various measures to control the spread of COVID-19 in the college premises and providing a safe environment to the students, faculty and staff. In continuation of that the Covid-19 Task Force worked on the above-mentioned objectives and came up with the following measures to maintain the academic and administrative activities in the college:

- (1) Distribution of laptop to those students who have lost their parents due to pandemic.
- (2) Monthly financial assistance Rs. 3000 to above students
- (3) Free Metro/Bus pass facility,
- (4) Free stationery.
- (5) Fee waivers for students who lost their parents to COVID-19 or who were affected seriously by COVID-19 and provided books for the whole semester.

(6) PGDAV College(eve) has decided for continuous and free COVID-19 vaccination (for all eligible age group) as well as booster dose facility for the students, faculty even for the general public. Proper sanitization of Administrative and Institutional buildings was conducted at regular interval. Thermal scanning as well as sanitization provided at all entry points at to handle the large crowds of both students and staff.

Culture and Ethics Cell

The Culture and Ethics Cell of PGDAV College (E), University of Delhi organised several events from July 22, 2022 to April 23, 2023. A talk on the topic “Turning Crisis into Opportunity Through Seven Billion Acts of Goodness” in Lab 3 of the college was organized on October 18, 2022. Chief Guest BK Ram Singhal (a professional civil engineer and owner of an engineering consulting firm in New York) delivered the talk, introducing students to a global campaign, named “7 Billion Acts of Goodness” and defined it is an inter-faith initiative intended for common people at grass-root level. With the purpose of connecting students with the sources of wisdom and expanding the probability of spiritual upliftment and hence adding value in their holistic development, the Cell, in collaboration with ISKCON, New Delhi set up a stall of ancient Vedic books including Bhagavad Gita in the college premises. Internal Quality Assurance Cell

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) is a statutory body mandated by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC). The Cell comprises members from all the stake-holders—administration, teaching staff, students, alumni and the employers of our former students of the college. The Cell keeps a track of all the activities happening in the college by collecting and analysing data with the help of several committees round the year. In its routine meetings, it discusses several issues and suggests activities, which can help improve the teaching-learning process in the college. Apart from collecting data and preparing reports (AQAR) for its annual submission to the NAAC authorities, it conducts Academic, Administrative and Environment Audits and Gender Audit. Further to these routine annual activities, the Cell also organised a number of activities for the students, faculty members and non-teaching staff this year. On July 25, 2022, the Cell organised, 'Youth Parliament Sitting 2022' in collaboration with Abhivyakti - The Youth Parliament Committee and others in which 55 students participated. A Webinar on "Role of youth in mitigating HIV/AIDS" was organised in collaboration with Red Ribbon Club on 14 September 2022. The programme was followed by a poster making competition on the same theme. In the next month, the Cell collaborated with SAVI (Students' Association for Verbal Interaction), Sankalp and Athena to organise Inter-college Quiz competition on the occasion of Vigilance Awareness Week 2022 on 14. 11. 2022. The event had cash prizes which was sponsored by Central Bank of India and a total of 42 students participated in it. A webinar on 'Millets for Health and Sports' was organised in collaboration with the Department of Physical Education and Sports and others on 28.11. 2022. The programme was attended by 80 people including teaching and non-teaching staff of the college. The valedictory session of the Sanskrit Sambhashan Shivir was held on 15.2.23 to award certificates to all the participants who attended the week-long program. The cell along with The Teachers' Welfare

Committee organised a webinar on the topic " Compression of all Investments for Wealth Creation" conducted by Mr Vijay Kaushik on 18.2.23. The webinar was attended by 30 faculty members who found the webinar very pertinent for making prudent investment decisions. The Cell collaborated with YUVA for a very relevant talk on "Dehdaan hai Mahadan" on 20.2.23, wherein the importance of donating the body after death was discussed in detail. Abhivyakti, Samprabhu and IQAC jointly organised a talk on "India's G-20 Presidency- Leadership in a changing World" on 21.2.23 which was attended by teachers and students . A webinar on "Fundamentals of GST" was organised jointly by Commerce Association, Vidya Vistar Scheme and BA Program committee on 27.2.23. The Mother Tongue Cell, IQAC, YUVA, WUS and NSS collaborated together for a Cultural program which was attended enthusiastically by the students on 25.2.23. The Cell organised, one week 'Free Computer Awareness Course' in blended mode from 27 March to 1st April 2023 for the First-year students. Around 80 students enrolled for this course. The classes were conducted online and hands-on practice sessions were taken in the computer lab (physical mode). A forty-two hours (7 days) Management Development Programme (MDP) on 'ICT Tools for Effective Institutional Management' from March 27, 2023 to April 10, 2023 was conducted for the non-teaching staff of the college. To felicitate our students who have graduated from our college, an Alumni Meet, 'Sanskriti ' was held on 16.4.23. This meet was attended by around 682 pass out students who were quite excited to come to their Alma Mater again and meet their teachers in college. The Light, Water and Sanitation Committee, WUS, Srishti and IQAC jointly organised a slogan writing competition on 15.4.23. Along with Shashwat, The Yoga Club, Culture and Ethics cell and IQAC organised a session on "Sahaj Yoga" on 19.4.23 which was attended by 15 teachers and 30 students who were explained the benefits of this technique for overcoming stress. The aim of this event was to educate people about the causes, symptoms, and prevention of AIDS in an engaging way. The speaker was Dr. Harshada Mulay, HR and General Management Faculty from ITM business School Kharghar Navi Mumbai. The objective of webinar was to familiarise students with ideation and brain-storming process. Students also became aware of the endless start-up possibilities in the digital world. The speaker was Dr. Harshada Mulay, HR and General Management faculty from ITM business school Navi Mumbai with experience of more than 20 years. To Celebrate National Education Day a Speech Competition was organised by Skill, Innovation & Entrepreneurship Cell (SIEC) (IIC) & ENACTUS jointly on 26th November 2022. The topic was National Education Policy 2022-A boost to Entrepreneurship. A field trip was organised on January 28, 2023 by Skill Innovation and Entrepreneurship Cell(SIEC)/IIC and Enactus in collaboration with Srishti-The Environment society to JanaJal Water on Wheels (WoW). It is an enterprise which provide safe and potable water to the nearby residents and communities at a highly subsidized rate. JanaJal WoW also developed expertise on rainwater harvesting and installed a complete setup for the same at its registered office in Noida. 49 participants visited JanaJal WoW enterprises (SD 96 A Sector 45, Noida – 201301) on to observe and understand the setting of water enterprise and rainwater harvesting system. A field trip was organised on February 8, 2023 by Skill Innovation and Entrepreneurship Cell(SIEC)/IIC and Enactus in collaboration with Srishti-The Environment society. The steps/phases involved in the plant in treating the sewage water were demonstrated to the students. Students also visited the water park behind the Sewage Treatment Plant where some of the treated water is discharged. National Science Day is celebrated on 28th February every year to mark the discovery of Raman effect, by Indian physicist C. V. Raman on 28 February 1928. Sir C.V. Raman was awarded Nobel Prize in Physics in year 1930 for his discovery. To celebrate National Science Day, a webinar on Importance of Innovation for Sustained Growth was organised by Skill Innovation and Entrepreneurship cell (SIEC)/

Institution & Innovation Council(IIC) and Enactus with Srishti-The Environment Society on 24 February 2023. To celebrate National youth day and National start-up day, a webinar was organised on 14th January 2023. Srishti – Environment Society

Under the Vidya Vistar Scheme, Srishti – the Environment Society, in collaboration with the IQAC and Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav cell, organized a webinar on Rainwater Harvesting on July 01, 2022 (Friday). Dr. Avnish Kr. Verma, Safe Water Network India was the speaker during the event who gave detailed account, necessity and benefits of rainwater harvesting. Ms. Sanchita Pandita, representative of Mahatma Gandhi National Council of Rural Education, Ministry of Education, Govt. of India visited the college on July 08, 2022 and observed different initiatives taken by the college for environmental conservation and awareness. On August 10, 2022, saplings were planted within the college premise to celebrate the centenary year of the University of Delhi. A plantation drive was conducted by Srishti in collaboration with NSS and NCC. Two ‘Aerobin’ composters provided by Indian Pollution Control Association (IPCA) under the CSR fund by Swarn Lata Motherson Trust were installed within the college premise. The composters were inaugurated on September 07, 2022 jointly by Prof. R.K. Gupta, Principal, Shri Shailendra Kumar Singh, ADM South – East Delhi, Dr.Radha Goyal, Deputy Director, IPCA. These composters will be used for converting the food waste into manure. Team IPCA played a skit to propagate awareness among the students. A workshop was also conducted for the house keeping staff to aware them about the solid waste management. The event was jointly organized by the environment committee and waste management committee. The annual function of Srishti and investiture ceremony was organized on the same day where the passed-out office bearers were awarded with trophies while the present office bearers were given badges. An industrial visit to Indian Pollution Control Association (IPCA) Plastic Recycling Plant, Plot No 66, Eco Tech 12, Greater Noida (West) (U.P.) was jointly organized on September 16, 2022, by the Environment Committee, Waste Management Committee, Students’ Association for Verbal Interaction (SAVI), Entrepreneurship & Skill Development Cell, ENACTUS, Industry Institution Interaction Cell (IIIC) and National Innovation and Startup Policy (NISIP). A field excursion to Okhla Bird Sanctuary for Vihang – the bird watching club was organized on October 15, 2022. Almost 50 student volunteers of Srishti and SANKALP attended Ganga Utsav – an annual event organized by National Mission for Clean Ganga (NMCG), Ministry of Jal Shakti, Govt. of India on

November 04, 2022. Student volunteers of Srishti and SANKALP of the college and members of Jaladhikar Foundation came together to conduct mass plantation drive on November 06, 2022 near ponds created by Jaladhikar in Greater Noida west. The Principal Prof. R. K. Gupta, Shri Kailash Goduka, Jaladhikar Foundation and Shri Gopal Krishna Agrawal were present along with other volunteers who actively participated in plantation drive. Srishti and Jaladhikar foundation jointly organized a workshop on January 14, 2023 to create awareness about the commercialization of water. Almost 30 students were present in the event. Two ‘Aerobin’ composters provided by Indian Pollution Control Association (IPCA) under the CSR fund by Swarn Lata Motherson Trust were installed within the college premise. The composters were inaugurated on September 07, 2022 jointly by Prof. R.K. Gupta, Principal, Shri Shailendra Kumar Singh, ADM South – East Delhi, Dr. Radha Goyal, Deputy Director, IPCA. These composters will be used for converting the food waste into manure. Team IPCA

played a skit to propagate awareness among the students. A workshop was also conducted for the house keeping staff to make them aware about solid waste management. The event was jointly organized by the environment committee and waste management committee. An industrial visit to Indian Pollution Control Association (IPCA) Plastic Recycling Plant, Plot No 66, Eco Tech 12, Greater Noida (West) (U.P.) was jointly organized on September 16, 2022, by the Environment Committee, Waste Management Committee, Students' Association for Verbal Interaction (SAVI), Entrepreneurship & Skill Development Cell, ENACTUS, Industry Institution Interaction Cell (IIC) and National Innovation and Startup Policy (NISP). Principal Prof. R.K. Gupta, Dr. Mayank Pandey (Convener, Environment Committee, Waste Management Committee and SAVI), Ms. Sonia Dhingra (Convener, Entrepreneurship & Skill Development Cell and ENACTUS), Dr. Sonika Nagpal (Convener, NISP) and Mr. Manoj Kumar (Member, Entrepreneurship & Skill Development Cell) and Ms. Tanishka Gupta (faculty member, Dept. of Commerce) were present during the visit along with fifty – six students from the above-mentioned cells/societies. The college collaborated with Indian Pollution Control Association (IPCA) to start organic farming in the college campus where the manure produced by the aerobin and pit composting will be used for the organic farming. The biodegradable waste (kitchen waste, left-over food, gardening waste etc.) is converted to manure using in-house compost pit. At present, 350-400 kg (approx.) compost has been formed, which will be used as manure for gardening purpose. Also, the WMC and ENACTUS jointly came together to make packets of manure (5 kg each) formed in the compost pits and sell the packets to the teaching and non-teaching staff, students and outsiders at highly subsidized rate (Rs 30 per kg). Being a bulk consumer, the college files annual e-waste returns with Delhi Pollution Control Committee. The college filed e-waste returns for the year 2021-22 also in May 2022. Jaagruti – Paper Waste Recycling Services collected 440 kg paper waste from the college campus for its recycling and provided equivalent number of fresh A4 sheet reams and recycling certificate to the college.

WUS Cell
