ANNUAL REPORT 2023-24

Greetings!

I firmly believe that behind the present form of any institution is actually the contribution and blessings of its former functionaries and senior colleagues, for which today I pay my respects to all the former principals, chairmen and members of the administrative committee of the college with whose blessings our college is continuously progressing and has succeeded in creating a special place in the world of education.

This annual function of the college is taking place at a time when the grand festival of elections is going on in India, the world's largest and strongest democracy. It is the result of our deep faith in democracy that when in the European and so-called developed countries, only a limited number of people had the right to vote and women were kept away from this right, at that time we considered age as the only basis for all voters and every Indian citizen was given the right to vote. Department of Physical Education & Sports Sciences

Add-on Courses

The college successfully ran three add-on courses in this academic year: Basic German Language Course (Convenor: Mr Manoj Kumar), Skill Development & Data Analytics (Convenor: Dr Sonika Nagpal), Legal Awareness Course-14th (Prof Meena Sharma).

Legal Awareness Course – 14th: Apart from the formal courses, the college has also started many supplementary courses with the aim of highlighting the natural talent and creative skills of the students and their overall personality development. Taking this idea forward, the first batch of 'Legal Awareness' course was started in the college in the year 2016. Since then, a total of 14 batches have been completed. The 14th batch of Legal Awareness Program was inaugurated on October 30, 2023 under the joint aegis of DLSA South East. Mr. Vinik Jain was present as the chief guest in the program. A total of 10 sessions were organized in this program this year. In the program, eminent judges and lawyers mainly gave detailed information on topics like DLSA, POCSO Act, Traffic Challan, E-FIR, Hindu Marriage Act and Gender Justice etc. A total of 43 participants participated in this course. The cell visited Police Station, Kalkaji on 5th December, 2023 under the guidance of Advocate Shri Sanjay Dutt. Tihar Jail was visited on 7th December, 2023 under the guidance of Advocate Shri Sandeep Mishra with the objective of familiarizing the students with real situations. Saket Court was visited on 15th February, 2024 under the guidance of Advocate Shri Sanjay Dutt with the objective of providing court related information to the students. The closing ceremony of the 14th batch of Legal Awareness Programme was successfully concluded on 21st February, 2024. The closing ceremony was graced by the presence of Shri Rajnish Kumar Gupta L.D.- Chief District & Sessions Judge cum Chairman, (DLSA South East) as Chief Guest and Shri Vinik Jain as Special Guest. Certificates were distributed to all the participants at the end of the programme. Nikhil, Student Coordinator of 14th Batch of Legal Awareness Programme, a student of 3rd year of Mathematics Department was also awarded a certificate and memento.

Workshop on Skill Development and Data Analytics: An Add-on course on 'Skill Development and Data Analytics' was organized in the college from June 19-29, 2023 by the Institution's Innovation Council (IIC), Women Development Cell (WDC), G-20, IT Cell, Internal Quality and Assurance Cell and World University Service (WUS), in collaboration with Learning Links Foundation (LLF), a non-profit organisation dedicated to enriching lives through learning. The objective of this program was to encourage students to build their interest, knowledge and expertise in a high-demanding Technology/STEM career path of data and analytics. It also aimed at enhancing the job readiness skills of the beneficiaries and to provide them an opportunity to enroll in globally recognized certification programs through online skill development platforms such as Coursera, Udemy etc. It was a 20 hrs. course including hands-on training on Advanced MS Excel spanning 15 hrs. and sessions on Communication Skill Building spanning 5 hrs. The inaugural session began with invoking the blessings of almighty and showing respect to our institution through PGDAV Gaan. Dr. Sonika Nagpal, Convenor of IIC formally welcomed the guest, trainers and all the attendees of the course. The sessions were taken by Mr. Sonu Gupta, the trainer from LLF. On Day 1, he covered the theoretical

framework of MS Excel and explained various important concepts such as meaning of data, types of data, pre-processing of data, basic statistics and fundamentals of excel. The topics covered on Day 2 included- Data formatting, excel list function and importing and exporting data, Customizing ribbon, Count function and Creating custom list. On Day 3 topics such as Sumif, Sumifs, Countif, Countifs, transpose function and Conditional formatting were covered. The session on Day 4 was on Data validation, Match, Index V look up, H look up look up and Sort and filter functions. On Day 5 the trainer covered Pivot table, Pivot chart, Python, Type casting, bool and string. The session on Day 6 was on Sequence of bit storage, set, dict, type casting and arithmetic operations. The session on Day 7 was on if, if else, range function, def function and how to write 2 to 100 table in python. 8th session was on Numpy library, Pandas library, Basic power query, Power BI and Data modeling. 9th session was on DAX function, and Group by, Creating dashboard. The last session was on Communication skills and after that a test was administered by the trainer. On the concluding day of the workshop, Dr. Sonika Nagpal summed up the contents of the workshop and proposed a formal vote of thanks. This add-on course proved to be fruitful for the students as the trainers explained the technical topics in a simple, interesting and interactive manner.

Basics of German Language Course: On the occasion of Bharat's G20 Presidency, the University of Delhi decided to organize cultural-cum-academic events across its affiliated departments and colleges. Our college is, one of the fifteen prestigious colleges from the University, selected to host a country of focus from the G20 Forum that is Germany. In this cycle, we have introduced a Basic German Language Course that commenced from 28th August 2023 to 20th September 2023. By understanding the value of linguistic diversity and intercultural communication in the globalised world of today, the institution works to provide its students with useful language skills that can improve their chances both academically and professionally. This course consisted of total 20 hours [in offline mode] with a nominal registration fee for all that is Rs 500/-. The course attracted significant interest with 41 enthusiastic students enrolling to embark on their German language journey. Ms. Preeti Gola, a German language teacher, used a multidimensional method of instruction to accommodate students with varying learning preferences and styles. She used cutting-edge techniques like role-playing and storytelling in addition to written exercises and spoken explanations to immerse pupils in authentic language situations. These interactive learning strategies not only improved understanding but also encouraged learners' creativity and critical thinking. Notably, the addition of multimedia materials to the curriculum—such as films and online exercises—enhanced the educational process and made difficult subjects more approachable and interesting. She also incorporated group discussions as students were divided into small groups to discuss various topics related to the German language and culture. These discussions were guided by Ms. Preeti that catered sufficient opportunity to students to practice their speaking and listening skills in a supportive environment. They also gained valuable insights into different aspects of the language, enhancing their overall learning experience. Lastly, it promoted collaboration and teamwork, fostering a sense of community among students and encouraging active participation in the learning process. It proved to be a valuable endeavour, offering students a solid foundation in German language skills and cultural understanding. By imparting essential linguistic competencies and fostering a supportive learning environment, the course empowered students to navigate the complexities of the German language with confidence and proficiency.

Mentor-Mentee Committee

The college wishes to provide the students an ideal, stress-free atmosphere, proper guidance and counselling (academic as well as non-academic). For this purpose the college has been following mentor-mentee practice for the last several years. We have divided the students of the college in small groups and each group is allotted with a member from the teaching faculty as Mentor. Under the system, the information of mentor-mentee is displayed on college website through two notices, one notice for the mentors along with the department wise teacher list was attached with it, in which in front of teacher's name their mentees class and roll numbers were given and another notice for the students along with the class wise list of students along with their mentor's name with department. The information is also mailed to both teachers and students. The list of official mail ids of all the mentors is also mailed to the students so that they can contact their mentors. Mentors can find the list of mentees, their phone number and email ids on their portal. The mentee can also see their mentor's name on the student portal. Girl students are advised to share their problems with any female teacher in case they are uncomfortable to share with the male mentor. The Mentor-Mentee ratio for the session 2023-24 is 1:32 . The system has provided the students emotional as well as physical support , whenever required.

Waste Management Committee

MCD Central Zone invited and presented our college as a role model for effective and efficient solid waste management, in an event organised on October 31, 2023. IPCA and Swarnlata Motherson Trust jointly awarded the college, 1st position under Gold category for effective solid waste management. Food and Organic Waste: the biodegradable waste (kitchen waste, left-over food, gardening waste etc.) is converted to manure using in-house compost pit. At present, 350-400 kg (approx.) compost has been formed, which will be used as manure for gardening purpose. Also, the WMC and ENACTUS jointly came together to make packets of manure (5 kg each) formed in the compost pits and sell the packets to the teaching and non-teaching staff, students and outsiders at highly subsidized rate (Rs 30 per kg). Being a bulk consumer, the college files annual e-waste returns with Delhi Pollution Control Committee. The college filed e-waste returns for the year 2022-23. Jaagruti – Paper Waste Recycling Services collected 1033 kg paper waste from the college campus for its recycling and provided equivalent number of fresh A4 sheet reams and recycling certificate to the college. Under My 10 kg waste campaign, IPCA collected 85 kg of plastic and polymer waste from the college.

Internal Quality Assurance Cell

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell has been dedicated to focus on quality assurance and quality enhancement activities in college. In our college, we believe that excellence is not an endpoint but an ongoing journey. Towards achieving this objective, the IQAC has had collaborations with many committees and cells in the college and the University. The valedictory function of the centenary celebrations of University of Delhi was graced by our honourable Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi , this event was screened live on 30th June

2023 in the staffroom. An exhibit of our college was also shown in the exhibition in University of Delhi for the Prime Minister. An annual and administrative audit was successfully held on 14 June 23, as per the NAAC requirements. In our college four Associate Professors were promoted to Professor on 22 May 2023. The historical moment of India's lunar roving vehicle, Chandrayaan -3 landing on the moon was streamed live on 23 August 2023. On 12th February 2024, the IQAC collaborated with CPDHE to organise a webinar on 'National Credit Framework' by Prof. Namita Rajput . On 15th February 2024 a delegation of academicians from HSE University ,St. Petersburg, Russia visited our college to interact with the faculty members and students. They delivered a talk on 'Computational Social Science for the 21st century: Studying people's' Digital Footprints 'and for the students, the topic was 'Multiple faces of Security : Theoretical and Empirical Approaches '. A two day, National Conference was organised on 8th and 9th March 2024 on the topic 'Nurturing Start-up and Entrepreneurship Culture in Viksit Bharat @ 2047, Conquering Challenges and Embracing Opportunities '. This was done in collaboration with Department of Commerce, Entrepreneurship cell and IQAC. Our cell has collaborated with the Department of Sanskrit to organise a 'Patrvachan Pratyogita' on 7th March 2024 and to celebrate the Hindu New Year and Foundation Day of Arya Samaj on 9th April 2024. In order to make the academic, administrative, financial and other dimensions of the college more efficient, the IQAC is conducting internal audit at present.

Women Development Cell

Rajbhasha Prakosth

In the month of May 2022, Rajbhasha Prakosth was established in D.A.V College (Evening) as per the instructions of University of Delhi, the objective of which is to adopt Hindi as the first language in bilingual form at all related points in compliance with the Official Language Policy of the Government of India. It should be used compulsorily and English language should be used as the second language. In this article, some rubber stamps were made in Hindi on August 3, 2022. Along with this, letter heads, file covers, identity cards of students and employees, leave forms, medical forms and addresses on envelopes etc. are being printed in bilingual form in Hindi as the first language and English as the second language. In this series, appointment letters were also given to the newly appointed permanent teachers in the college in both the languages, Hindi and English. Along with this, the prospectus of the college was also printed in both Hindi and English. The annual report of the college is also printed/published in both Hindi and English languages. In the recent past, all the name plates in the library and computer lab on every floor of the college have been made in both Hindi and English languages, the information coming out in the college is also mostly published in both the languages. Original self-written compositions by three faculty members of P.G.D.A.V College (Eve) have also been sent to the cell for publishing in the in-house magazine of the university. To comply with the official language policy, the Rajbhasha Prakosth of the college has published some programmes and workshops were also organised as per the instructions of the Principal. With this view, on June 20, 2023, under the joint aegis of G20, Vidya Vistar Scheme and Abhivyaakti Youth Parliament, by the Rajbhasha Prakosth and Internal Quality Assurance Committee of P.G.D.A.V College (Eve), a training programme was organised through virtual (online) medium, in which senior professor Puran Chand Tandon ji was present as the keynote speaker. 50 professors of the college participated in this programme of official language Hindi training. On October 14, 2023 "Sahitya Kala Sangam" was organised under the joint aegis of Indradhanush, Hindi Sahitya Sabha, Official Language Cell, Drishyam, Athena and Udaan Sanstha. Under this, four competitions were successfully completed at the inter-college level, the first competition was of recitation of self-written poetry, in which 53 students participated, the second competition was of speech making, 79 students participated, the third competition was of poster making, in which 35 students participated, the fourth The competition was for photography. In which 15 students participated. In the end, the awarded participants were given trophies, college magazine and certificates and participation certificates were given to all the participants. In this series, a one-day literary festival will be organised on November 7, 2023 under the joint auspices of Hindi Sahitya Sabha and Official Language Cell. Under this, three competitions were conducted at inter-college level in Hindi, in which the first competition was quiz, the second was essay writing and the third was self-composed poetry competition. A total of 40 students participated enthusiastically in all the three competitions. On November 23, 2023, under the

joint aegis of Internal Quality Assurance Committee, Hindi Sahitya Sabha, Fractals Mathematics Society and English Literary Society, a workshop was organised by the cell for the college professors, administrative staff and students regarding the implementation of the official language Hindi, the subject of which was "Use of official language Hindi in administration: Practical difficulties and solutions". In this programme, the main speaker Mr. Raghuvver Sharma (Assistant Director, Department of Official Language, Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India) while explaining the practical difficulties faced in the use of official language Hindi and their solutions, said that schools and colleges are the first steps which lay the foundation of Hindi. He also said that achieving the situation of bilingualism is also important for the development of the official language Hindi. Due to this, the use of English may not have ended, but the use of Hindi has increased significantly. He told that at present Hindi language is a rapidly growing language. Raghuvver ji drew attention to the fact that language is neither difficult nor easy but when put into practice it seems simple. In the end, he said that Hindi is the language which united everyone in the fight for freedom and in the future also this language is moving towards uniting India and making it a world leader again. 62 professors, 18 non-teaching staff and about 120 students participated in this programme and benefited from the official language implementation workshop. Samarth - The Competitive Exam Society

Shubh Ashish Society

On 9th November 2023, 14 students of Shubh Ashish Society celebrated a holy festival of Diwali with great enthusiasm with more than 250 elderly people in Guru Vishram Varidh Ashram, Gautampuri, New Delhi. During the festival, various sweets, fruits and socks were distributed to the elderly by our students. A dance competition was also organised by the students and after that shawls, sheets and warm tops were given to the elderly. The students served the elderly, everyone said that they are very happy and they feel as if they are celebrating this festival with their children. They gave their invaluable blessings for the bright future of our students. On 29th November 2023, 10 students of the Shubh Ashish Society served the elderly at Guru Vishram Varidh Ashram, Gautampuri, New Delhi and competitions like decoration and chess were also organised for the old age peoples to keep them happy. On 30th January 2024 under the joint aegis of Shubh Ashish, National Service Scheme, Gandhi Study and Yuva Samiti, 42 students served the elderly in Varidh Ashram, Okhla, New Delhi considering Gandhi ji's spirit of service as an ideal and provide family environment in the Ashram. On 6th February 2024, 15 students of Shubh Ashish Society served the people suffering from visual impairment at Blind Relief Association, New Delhi and interacted with them to know about their lifestyle. This team also met visually impaired students there and they told our students that along with studies, they are also participating in various skills related activities like sewing, art and craft,

massage therapy and various applications of computer. Our students told them that they will help them in their computer applications. On 20th February 2024, 17 students of this society served the elderly people in Guru Vishram Varidh Ashram, Gautampuri, New Delhi and after that the students distributed various types of fruits to the elderly people and the elderly people gave their invaluable blessings for the bright future of our students. On 1st March 2024, a public awareness campaign was organised in Barakhamba Road and nearby Connaught Place area in Delhi under the joint aegis of Shubh Ashish, Sansparsh, Rashtriya Seva Yojana, P.G.D.A.V College (Eve) and Jaladhikar Foundation United Residents of Delhi, The Legal Rights Organization of India on the subject of stopping the business of naturally provided water and diseases caused by plastic bottled water. In this campaign, Dr. Jaipal, Dr. Kuldeep Singh from P.G.D.A.V College (Eve) and Kailash ji from Jaladhikar Foundation and Sukarma Chaudhary of Rashtriya Swabhimani Andolan along with other officials and more than 75 students of the college participated and made people aware of the health and environmental problems caused by the use of a chemical called BPA in the manufacturing of the plastic. On 13th March 2024, 10 students of Shubh Ashish Society served visually impaired persons at Blind Relief Association, New Delhi and interacted with them to learn about their lifestyle. The team visited the lamp production, art and craft; sewing-cutting training and production, massage unit and various workshops present there and saw that this association is helping visually impaired people to become self-reliant by giving them training. Seeing the efforts of visually impaired people to become self-reliant, the students got inspired to work hard continuously in their life. On 19th March 2024, 14 students of Shubh Ashish Society celebrated the holy festival of Holi with the elderly at Guru Vishram Varidh Ashram, Gautampuri, New Delhi with great joy. Students and elderly people also participated in music and dance together and after that the students distributed various types of sweets to the elderly on the occasion of Holi festival. On 20th March 2024, the students of this society not only actively participated in the 'Blood Donation Mahadaan' camp in the college premises, but also donated blood with the resolve that they will continue to play their active participation with the same devotion and dedication in the future with the same spirit of service. Various local products covering a wide range of Fast-Moving Consumer Goods (FMCG) sector to consumer durables were included in the campaign where their operations starting from procuring raw materials to providing to the end consumers, was studied. Many students of the college were involved in this initiative. They explored information regarding the manufacturing and distribution channels of these products. Under this initiative, 148 business proposals were made by the efficient students of the college. In addition to these proposals, several students wrote blogs to promote and create awareness about such Startups and Micro Businesses in varied areas.

Library and Reading Room

In-Charge: Mr Pawan Kumar Mathaini

Library acts like the backbone of an educational institution and no educational environment can be complete without a library. From the most ancient material to the most modern, we can easily access written, recorded and published documents of research/inventions through the library. In an educational institution, the library is the only place to fulfil the need of books for students, teachers and employees. It is certainly with the help of the library that students are able to fulfil the real aim of education. From this point of view, our college library can be called fully capable.

Automation of college library:

In order to make the library more useful from the automation point of view, cloudbased library software Koha is working in the library. Students and faculty members can access information from their mobile phones while sitting at home through Koha software. Library service is made available so that they can easily search for their desired book. As of 31 March 2024, the library currently has 58,156 books on various subjects. In the academic session 2023 - 2024, 523 books worth Rs.2,26,100=00 have been purchased till 31st March 2024. 61 daily, weekly, monthly newspapers and magazines in Sanskrit, Hindi and English languages are regularly available in the reading room.

The importance of the library can be estimated from the fact that from 01 July 2023 to 28 March 2024, 91,958 books were issued for reading by the professors and students

from the college library. Library services are available in the college from 1:30 pm to 8:30 pm. Keeping the examinations in mind, the library opens one month before the examinations in order to provide additional study facilities to the students. Services are made available to

students from 9:00 a.m. The special facility to the students, the college library provides free breakfast/lunch from the canteen situated in the college premises.

In order to provide maximum benefit of the library services, the library is organizing library classes for the students taking admission in the session 2023-2024 on dates 01-02-2024, 02-02-2024 and 05-02-2024 from 2:00 PM to 3:00 PM Orientation programme was organised in the library as per the course. In which large number of students participated and took advantage of the library orientation program. During the orientation, library in-charge Mr. Pawan Kumar Maithani gave detailed information to the students on the following topics:

1. How to use the Library through OPAC
2. How to search books through OPAC (Library Software KOHA)
3. How to access E-Journals
4. How to access E-Books

Facility of E -Resource provided by the library: -

With the objective of providing maximum benefit of e-services to the faculty members and students of the college Remote Access facility was provided by Delhi University Library System free of cost.

Facility of DRILLBIT Plagiarism software in the library: -

Delhi University College Library has provided the facility of DRILLBIT Plagiarism for checking the quality (Plagiarism) of the research papers of the college faculty members.

The faculty members of the college can use the e-resources made available by Delhi University Library through remote access. To know how to search through (Remote Access), the library organized an online course on “How to use E-Resource of Delhi University Through Remote Access” on 15 June 2023 from 10:45 am. Subject expert Ms Bhawna Goswami-Head operations, Refread Solutions Pvt. Ltd. was the keynote speaker.

Book Exhibition: -

The following were organized by the library on the occasion of various important events organized in the college in the session 2023-2024.

Book exhibitions were organised on the following subjects: -

(i) College Organised Akhand Bharat Sankalp Diwas on 14th August 2023 and College Library organised Book Exhibition related to Partition of India.

(ii) On occasion of G20 the college organised a special programme Indian-German Treaty: Current Scenario and Future Direction on 30th October 2023 and library showcases the books related to German Literature.

(iii) On 22 January 2024, on the occasion of the Pranpratishtha of Shri Ram Lalla at Shri Ram Janmabhoomi Ayodhya, an exhibition of literature available in the form of Shri Ram literature preserved in the heritage of books was organized in the college library.

(iv) On 15 February 2024, on the occasion of the visit of an academic team from HSE University, St. Petersburg, Russia to the college, an exhibition of literature available on Russian language and literature was organized by the college library.

Special facility to Differently-abled students: -

With the aim of supporting differently-abled students in their studies, the college library purchased seven Daisy Player (Evo E11) for a total cost of Rs. 94,500=00 in the session 2023-2024 and distributed them free of cost to the differently-abled students. In the current session, five differently-abled students of the college are taking advantage of this facility.

Book Fund: -

The library fund in the college was established in 1975 with an assistance of Rs. 15,000 received from the University Grants Commission. At present there are 1,333 books in this fund. Books are provided to the students of the college for study throughout the year from this fund.

Student Assistance Fund: - Student Assistance Fund was established in 1958. Its main objective is to provide books to the students for the whole year. At present there are 4538 books in this fund. This year 322 books were provided to 40 students from the Book Fund. In the academic session 2023-2024, 52 books worth Rs. 23,684.00 were purchased in the Student Assistance Fund.

Book Gift Fund: - A book gift fund has been established in the library for free books received as gifts from college faculty members and students. At present, 904 books are available in this book gift fund.
